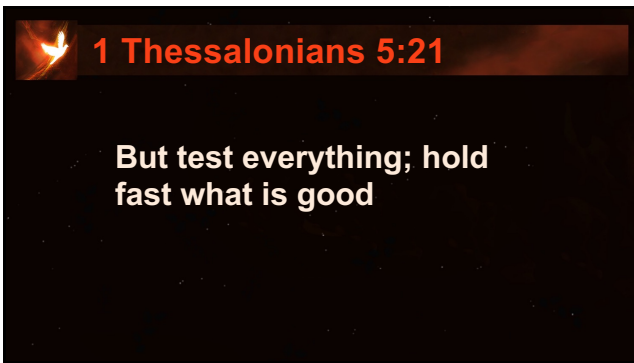
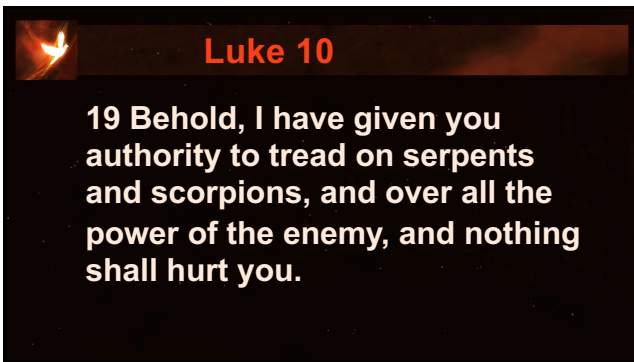

baskainō to bring evil on one by feigned praise or an evil eye, to charm, beguile. Literally to smite with the eye.


