
Confession is Acknowledgement

Confession is a public acknowledgement of our sin and our helplessness (our condition) and then Christ's righteousness and the power of His Lordship (His condition). Confession is the first step in a miraculous process of transformation.

Not Behavior Management

Christianity is not about behavior management, it is about receiving a new heart by faith and then learning to walk in the desires our new heart produces.

The Old Self is fashioned by deceitful desires based on lies and New Self is fashioned by godly desires based on truth

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A Desire Responds to Real Needs

A desire is our response to satisfy a real human need.
