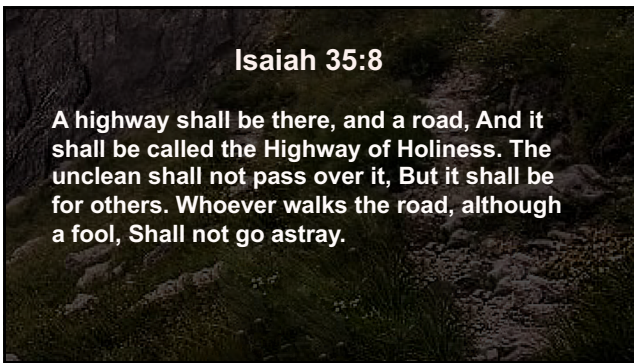
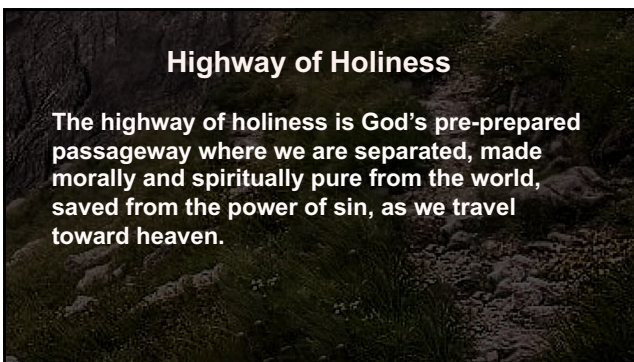

Self-realization

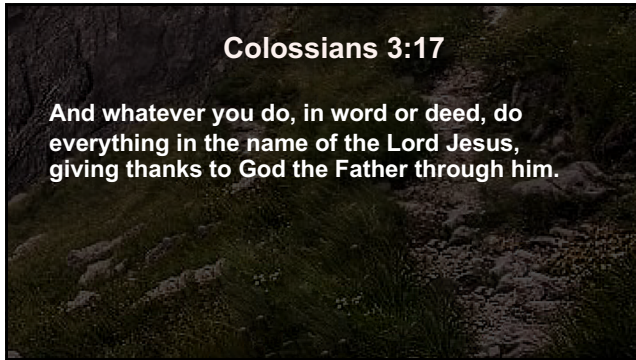
Self-realization is the fulfillment of one's potential or the understanding of one's true nature. It means achieving personal growth and becoming the best version of oneself.

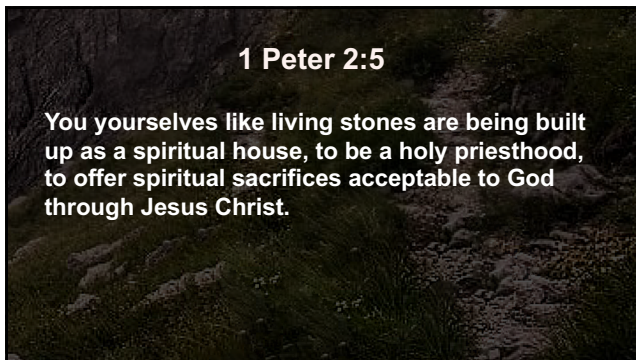
Christ-realization

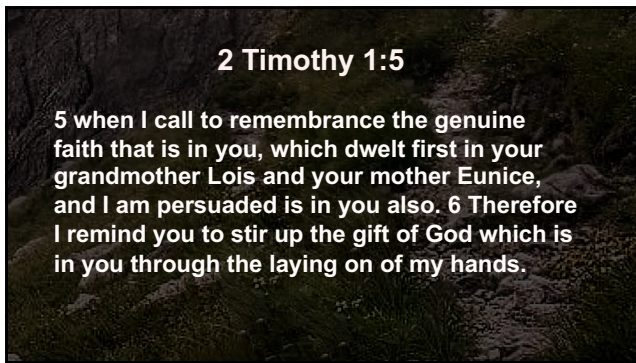
Acts 16:1-5

2 He was well spoken of by the brethren who were at Lystra and Iconium.

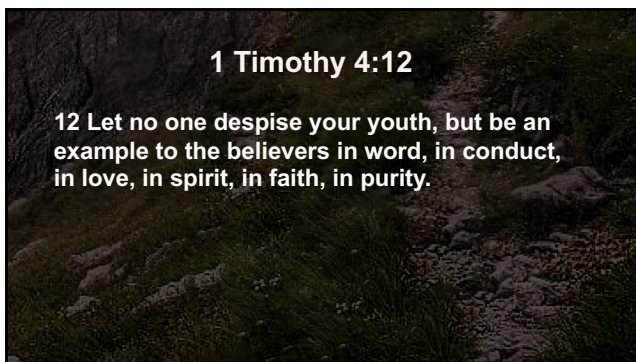
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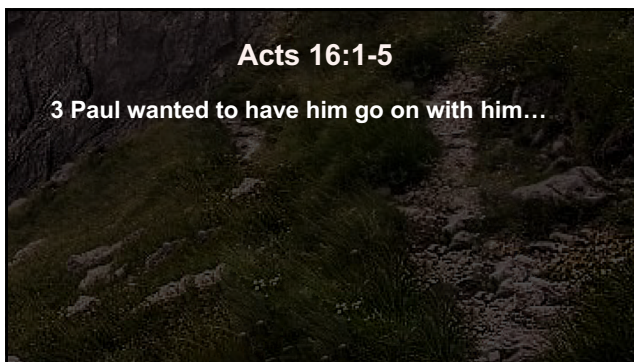
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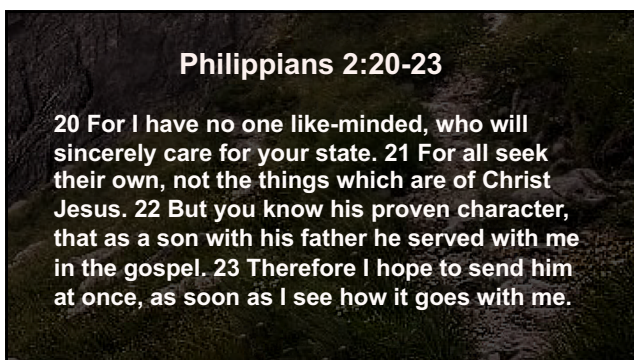

Circumcision was not for Salvation

"By Jewish law Timothy was a Jew, because he was the son of a Jewish mother, but because he was uncircumcised he was technically an apostate Jew. If Paul wished to maintain his links with the synagogue, he could not be seen to countenance apostasy."

Circumcision was a Cultural Decision

Paul circumcised Timothy not to ensure his salvation, but so that Timothy's status as a non-circumcised man from a Jewish mother would not hinder their work among the Jews and in synagogues. It was a cultural decision. Paul did things for the sake of love that he would not do in a vain attempt to please God through acts of the OT Law. Paul insisted that Titus, a Gentile co-worker, did not have to be circumcised.
