LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS:

Icebreaker: What comes to mind when you hear the word, “witnesses?”

Sermon Observation Questions

1. Was there anything from this past week’s sermon that stood out to you? Explain. Was there anything from the sermon that confused you? Explain. Was there anything from the sermon that invoked an emotion? If so, what was it?
2. Observations about this passage: Who was the audience or the characters? What does this passage tell us about sinful man? What do we learn about God or Jesus from reading this passage, and how does that impact the way we love people and love God?
3. What questions arise from reading this passage? Is there anything from this passage that sticks out to you personally? If so, what?

Life Application Questions

1. The disciples were very concerned about the future when Christ wanted them to be concerned with the present. When you’re going through a difficult season, do you tend to lean into it, or daydream about the future? Explain. Why does God want us to be focused on being faithful in the present despite confusion and chaos?
2. Why might it be difficult for the disciples to stay in Jerusalem, instead of heading back to their hometowns? As the disciples waited in Jerusalem they received the gift of the Holy Spirit; how has God blessed you, when you stuck with a difficult trial or time of life?
3. How do you relate to God in times of uncertainty? How has God encouraged you through this current season of life?
4. **Next Steps:** This week, what God-honoring steps can you take when the pieces of life don’t come together as you believe they should?
