What is a Stephen Minister?

Stephen Ministers are congregation members who undergo roughly 50 hours of intensive training in Christian caregiving. They do not attempt to replace clinical counselors or pastors, but rather offer consistent, empathetic listening and prayer to help carry the burdens of those going through transitional periods in their lives.
