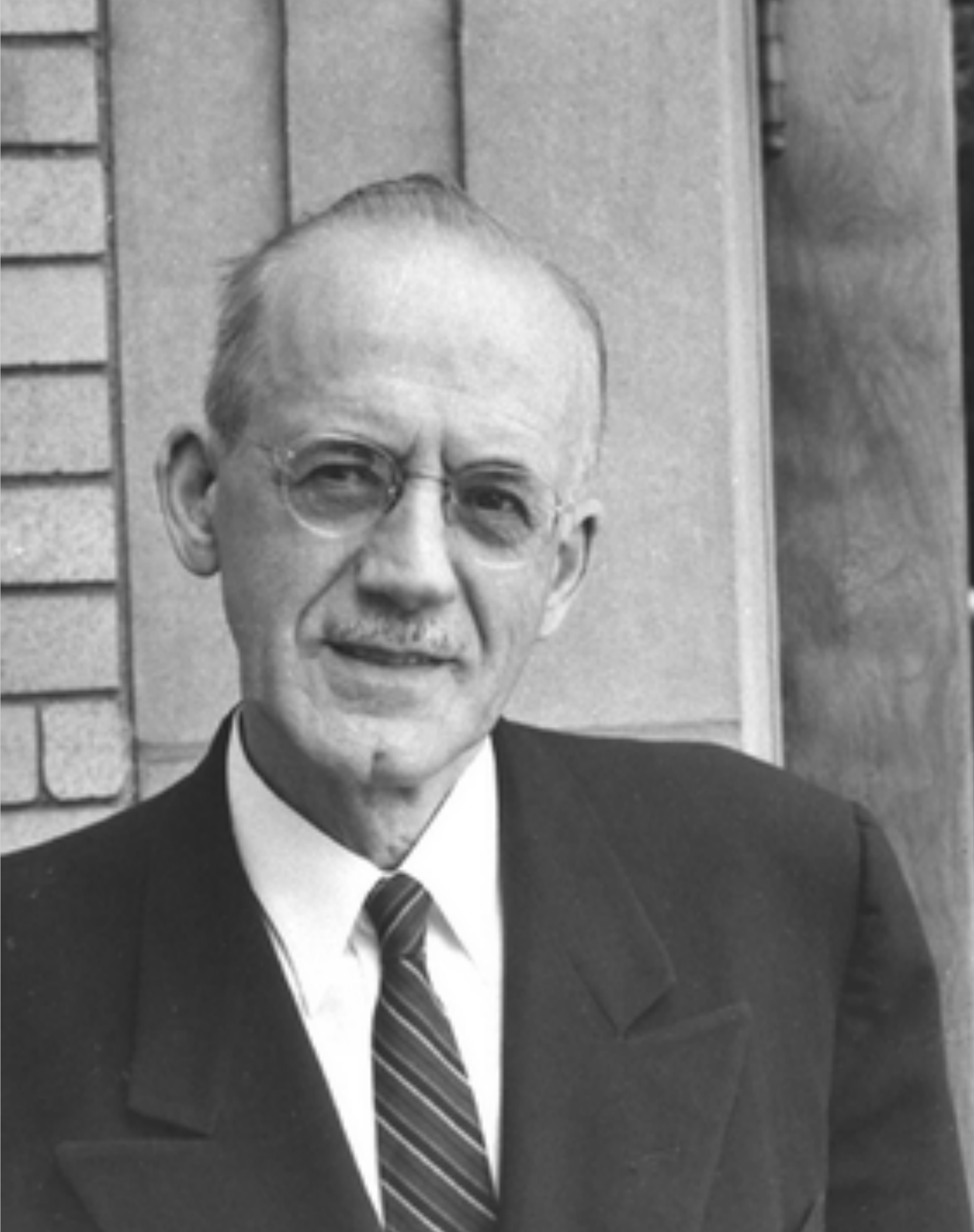

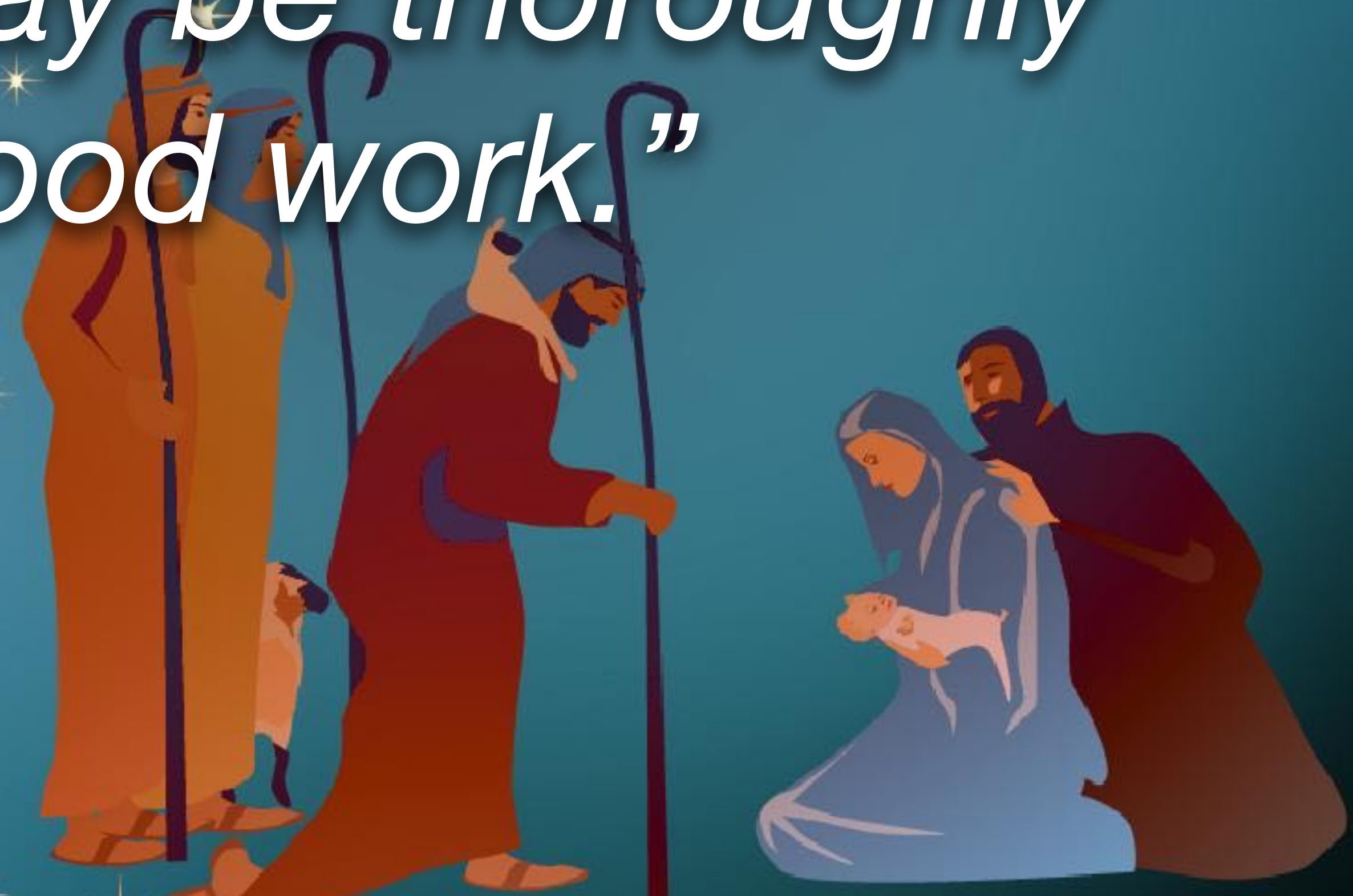
1. Through Scripture
