# Key verse of Colossians:

“So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him.” (*Colossians 2:6, NIV*)

The Son  
is the image of the invisible God,  
the firstborn over all creation.

*(Colossians 1:15, NIV)*

For in him  
all things were created:  
things in heaven and on earth,  
visible and invisible,  
whether thrones or powers or  
rulers or authorities; all things  
created through him and for him.

*(Colossians 1:16, NIV)*

He is  
before all things  
and in him  
all things hold together.

*(Colossians 1:17, NIV)*

the head of the body, the church;  
he is  
the beginning and the firstborn  
from among the dead
