No, O people, the Lord has told you what is good, and this is what he requires of you: **to do what is right, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God.**

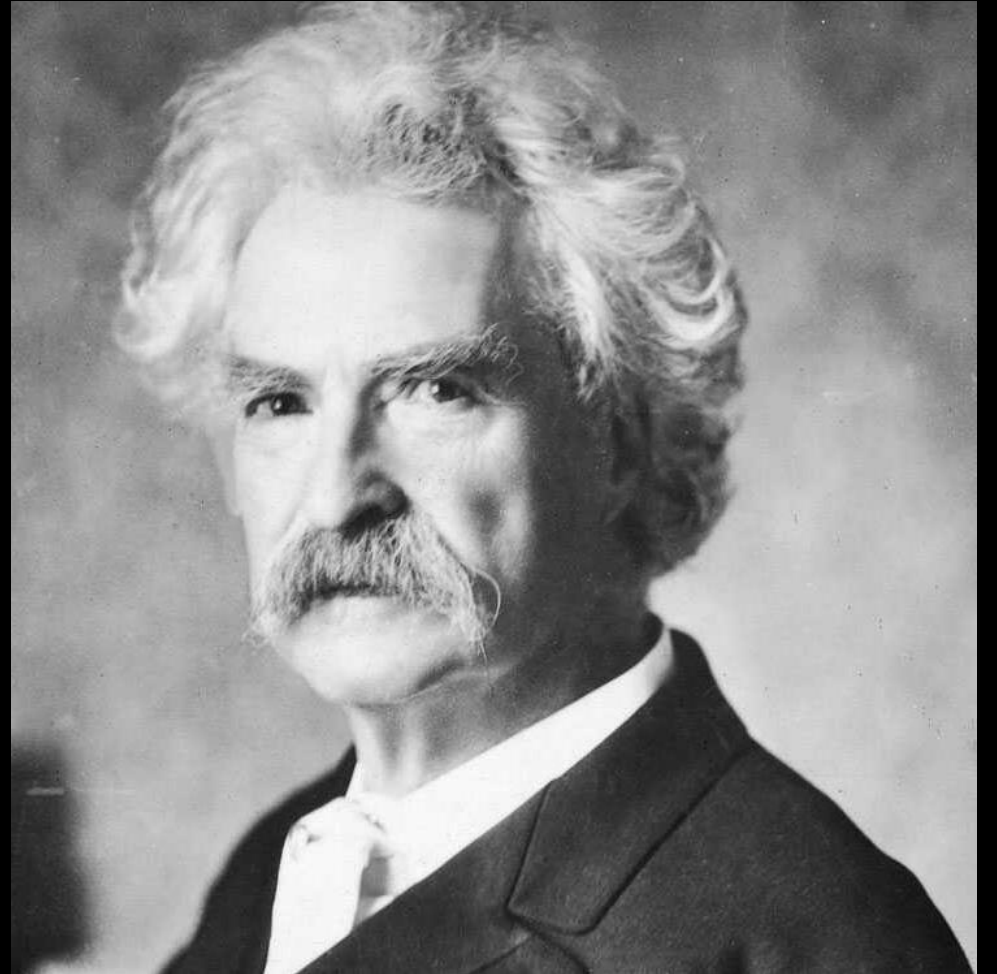

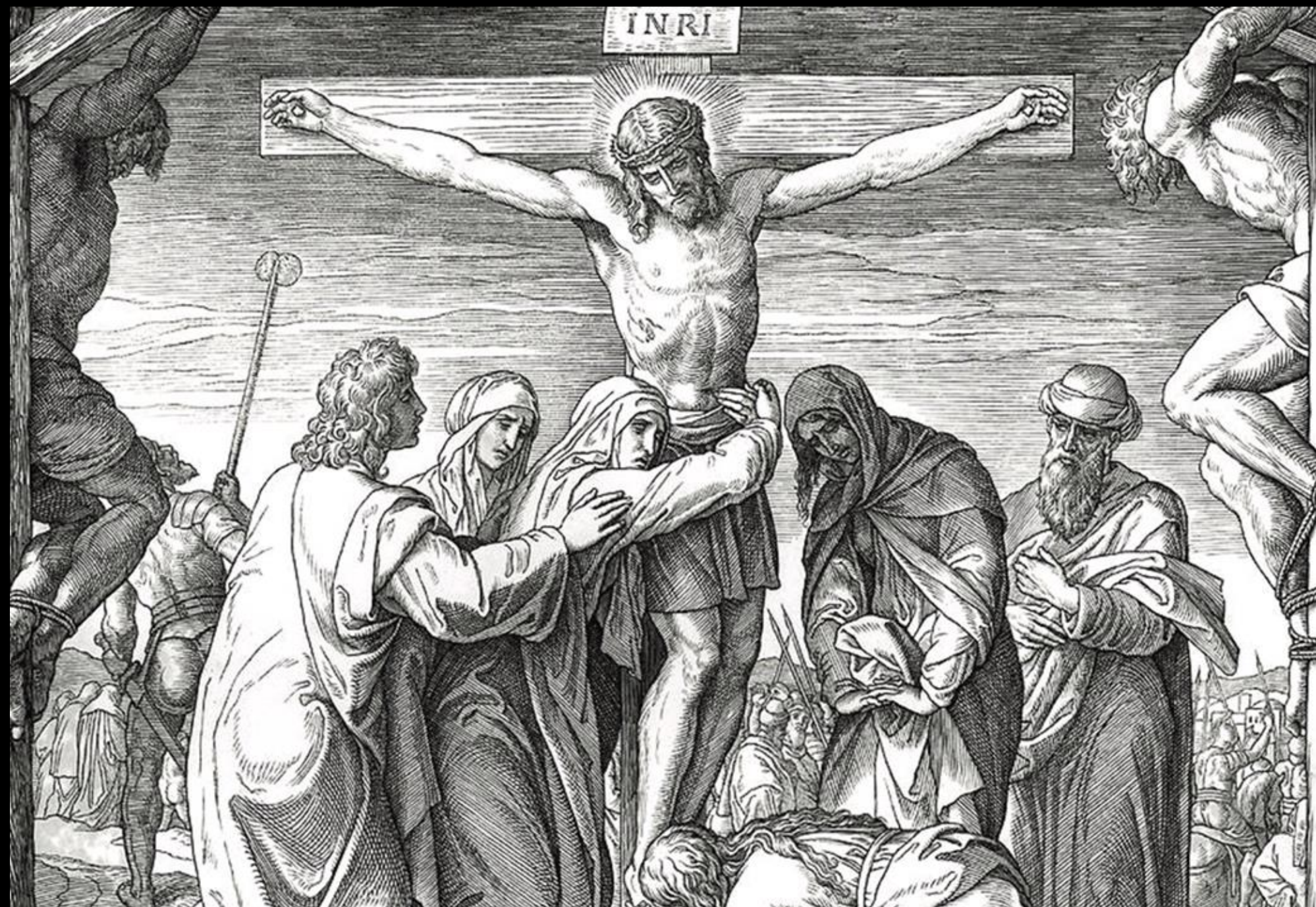
STEP 7: WAIT FOR THE PEACE OF GOD
