Introduction

Every Sunday of 2022, our Bible studies focus on JESUS Through the Eyes of Luke, from Luke's Gospel and his Book of Acts. Every Sunday we study and apply God's Word. This week, we find two parables that Jesus uses to describe what the Kingdom of God is like. We'll take a look at each parable and try to discover what Jesus was trying to teach about the Kingdom of God.

Study God's Word - Luke 13:18-21

- 1. The <u>Parable</u> of the <u>Mustard Seed</u> (18-19)
- 2. The <u>Parable</u> of the <u>Yeast</u> (vs. 20-21)

Apply God's Word

- 1. Many <u>People</u> Will Enter <u>Heaven</u>
 - a. People with different experiences
 - b. People who are different
 - c. People from every nation
- 2. Small Change Affects the Big Picture
 - a. An outside force causes the change
 - b. Change inside of us, affects those around us

Today we looked at two small things that had the potential to have a great impact on the things around them. When we look at the world as a whole, we may feel small or insignificant, but these passages remind us that God is at work in us, and we matter in the Kingdom of God! - 6. What changes do you need to allow God to make in your life so that you can be more effective for his Kingdom?
