

LIFE GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

March 29th

1. Gary describes Gethsemane as “the place we go when there’s no place to go but God.” **When have you experienced a moment like that—and what did it reveal about you?**
2. Jesus asks for the cup to pass, and also chooses surrender: “not what I will, but what you will.” **What do you notice in that tension between honesty and surrender—and where do you feel that tension in your own life?**
3. The image of fear and faith running like “parallel rails” is striking. **Have you experienced a season where both were present at the same time? What did that look like for you?**
4. Jesus didn’t need his friends to fix anything—just to be present. **What does it look like, in real life, to be that kind of presence for someone? And where might you need that kind of presence right now?**
5. Near the end, Gary suggests that strength isn’t found in how hard we fight, but in how fully we surrender. **How does that idea sit with you—comforting, unsettling, something else?**
