1. How would you describe your relationship with the book of Acts? Is it more like an acquaintance, a close friend, or somewhere in between?
2. The pastor said Acts is not about information but invitation. Where do you currently find yourself in that invitation—more of a watcher, a wanderer, or a witness?
3. Acts begins with only 120 believers—small, uncertain, but Spirit-filled. How does that perspective encourage you when you think about the challenges facing the church today?
4. We were reminded that the central characters of Acts are not Peter or Paul, but Jesus and the Spirit. How might remembering this shape the way you think about leadership, church life, or your own role in God's mission?
5. Boldness in Acts doesn't always look loud—it sometimes looks like persistent prayer, courage in opposition, or quiet faithfulness. Which expression of Spirit-filled boldness resonates most with you, and why?
