The Disruptive Spirit

- In Acts 2, the Spirit doesn't arrive quietly but with violent wind and fire. Why do you think God chose such disruptive signs to mark this moment?
- Key Question: When has God disrupted your life in a way that was uncomfortable but ultimately good?
 Continuity of God's Story
- The sermon highlighted how wind and fire echo God's presence throughout the Old Testament (creation, Sinai, burning bush, temple filling). How does seeing these connections shape the way you read Acts 2?
- What does it tell you about God's consistency and His long-term plan?

Everyone Was Filled

Unlike the Old Testament, where the Spirit came on select leaders, Acts 2 says "all of them were filled." How does this truth challenge or encourage the way you see yourself in God's mission today?

The Untamable Spirit

- The Spirit came outside of human planning or control. What does that reveal about the nature of the Spirit's work in the church?
- Key Question: Where might you personally be tempted to want to control or "manage" how God moves in your life?

Awake to New Creation

- Gary called Pentecost a "new creation moment," when God's breath animates His people as the new temple where heaven and earth overlap. What excites or challenges you about that identity?
- Key Question: What might it look like for our small group and church to live more fully as that Spirit-filled new creation community here and now?
