The Mission That Hasn't Changed

- How does that truth reshape your understanding of life with God?
- Key Question: What would it look like to enjoy the Spirit's presence rather than striving to earn it?

Wanderer, Watcher, or Witness?

We may find ourselves in different postures toward God's work — disappointed wanderers, hesitant watchers, or active witnesses.

- Key Question: Which posture best describes you right now?
- Key Question: What might a next step of faith look like in this season?

We were challenged to become a people who practice saying yes to the Holy Spirit - in big and small ways.

- What might saying "yes" to the Spirit look like for you right now?
- Key Question: How can we, as a community, support one another in living this out?
