

LIFE GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

This past Sunday, Matt guided us through the practice of Lectio Divina which is a slow, prayerful way of reading Scripture multiple times, paying attention to the words, ideas, or images that stand out. In place of our usual discussion questions, we invite your group to return to the same passage and walk through the Lectio Divina practice together. Using Matt's questions, reflect on them from a shared, group perspective, listening to one another and discerning what God might be inviting your community to notice, receive, or respond to through this text.

God, form us into people who are ready—present, responsive, and willing to live from Your peace.

Present

1. Where are you right now?
2. What might it take to remain present in the present this week?
3. How are you experiencing God in the present?

Responsive

1. What do you sense God inviting you into?
2. What do you want Jesus to do for you?
3. Any ways that you might be resisting the Lord?

Willing

1. What would you do if you were not afraid?
2. Is there an area of your life that might be hiding from healing?
3. What does following Jesus on the road look like for you this week?
