Key Takeaways:

Discussion Questions:

- 5. The sermon highlighted how Jehosheba's actions were crucial but hidden. In what areas of your life might God be calling you to serve or act faithfully behind the scenes?
- 6. How can we maintain courage and faithfulness even when we don't immediately see the results of our obedience?
- 7. Pastor Ike mentioned that Joash eventually turned away from God, despite Jehosheba's efforts. How can we stay encouraged when our efforts to help others don't turn out as we hoped?

- 2. Reflect on your current life path. Are there any areas where you need to reassess if your good intentions are truly leading to positive outcomes?

- Spend time in prayer, asking God to give you eyes to see opportunities where your small acts of faithfulness could have a significant impact.
