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# Weekly Devotional

## October 27 - 31, 2025

### THE SENT ONE

*Each day, read the assigned Scripture and reflect on how it connects to your life and the themes from Pastor Tim's message, "The Sent One." This 5 day devotional traces the journey from being called out by Jesus to being sent with His authority and empowered by the Holy Spirit. You will revisit the heartbeat of Genesis 3, see its fulfillment in Christ, and embrace your role as part of His ecclesia in everyday places. As you reflect, listen for how Jesus is restoring what was lost and inviting you into His mission. Use the daily reflections, questions, and prayer prompts to draw near to God, deepen your faith, and live as one sent to share His hope with the world.*

#### DAY ONE: CALLED OUT

##### READ

Matthew 16:18

##### REFLECT

In Sunday's sermon, Pastor Tim taught that Jesus called His followers the "ekklesia," meaning the called out ones. You are not an accident, and you are not simply part of a group. Jesus has claimed you as His own. He calls you into relationship, identity, and belonging. You were called out of darkness and into a life that reflects Him. The first step is recognizing that you truly belong to Jesus and His purpose.

##### QUESTION

What does it change about your identity to know that Jesus says you belong to Him?

##### PRAYER

- Thank Jesus for calling you.
- Ask for a deeper awareness of belonging to Him.

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#### DAY TWO: SENT WITH PURPOSE

##### READ

John 20:21

##### REFLECT

In Sunday's message we learned that Jesus not only calls us, but He sends us. You are part of the continuation of His mission on earth. He does not send you alone or in fear. He sends you with His authority and His presence. The mission is not just for a few gifted people. It is for every follower of Jesus, including you. When He says "I also send you," He is personally assigning you purpose.

##### QUESTION

Where has Jesus already placed you to live out His mission daily?

##### PRAYER

- Ask God to help you see your everyday places as your mission field.
- Invite Him to use you as His representative.

## DAY THREE: EMPOWERED BY THE SPIRIT

### READ

Acts 1:8

### REFLECT

You are called and sent, yet God never intended you to operate from your own strength. Jesus promised believers power through the Holy Spirit. That power transforms fear into courage and hesitation into obedience. The Spirit equips you to reveal Jesus with both your words and your actions. When you depend on the Spirit, you become part of something larger than yourself. God's power becomes visible in ordinary moments.

### QUESTION

How can you rely more on the Holy Spirit in your daily decisions and interactions?

### PRAYER

- Invite the Holy Spirit to fill and guide you.
  - Pray for boldness to love and serve like Jesus.
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## DAY FOUR: CONTINUE HIS MISSION

### READ

Matthew 28:19 to 20

### REFLECT

In Sunday's sermon, we heard that the mission of Jesus is now our mission. Sharing the love and truth of Jesus does not require perfection. It does require willingness. The disciples were once unsure too, yet they acted in obedience and the world changed. You carry the presence of Jesus wherever you go. God placed you in this exact time in history so that others would see Christ through you.

### QUESTION

Who is one person God might be asking you to reach out to this week?

### PRAYER

- Ask God to help you notice others who need encouragement or hope.
  - Pray for opportunity and courage to speak about Jesus.
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## DAY FIVE: ONE A DAY

### READ

Colossians 3:17

### REFLECT

You do not need to wait for the perfect moment to live the mission of Jesus. Start with one simple step. One conversation. One act of kindness. One prayer for someone in need. When you live with a "one a day" mindset, the Holy Spirit has room to work through your ordinary life. God delights in using small acts of obedience to make an eternal impact.

### QUESTION

What is one step you can take today to reflect Jesus to someone around you?

### PRAYER

- Ask God to guide you to one specific person today.
- Pray for the strength to act when the moment comes.
