7. What does it mean practically to “believe in His name”?
8. How does becoming a “child of God” reshape a person’s identity?
9. Why is it important that salvation is “not of blood... nor of the will of man... but of God”?
10. In what ways might someone “reject” Jesus today without openly saying they reject Him?
