- 3. Why did Pastor Jon start his message with God is God? Why does this point matter for this message?
 - a. How should having a full biblical view of God shape our response to evil?
- 4. Who should we blame for sin? (satan, demons, humans, God) Who do we normally blame for sin? Why is that your answer?
 - a. Why might someone who does not know God blame Him for sin?
- 5. What does the Bible teach us about God's character, and God's approach to evil?
- 6. Can you be content, like Job, with trusting God during great suffering—without answers but with God's presence and sovereignty? What makes this harder or easier for you?
- 7. How should the fact that God did, will, and is dealing with sin effect us in our every day lives?
 - a. How does this impact our call to forgive one another?
- 8. The problem with pain is real, how would you help someone struggling with chronic pain apply this?
