Standing Firm When It's Hard

August 30 · 2 Timothy 3:1–17

Discipleship questions for table groups, huddles, or one-on-one conversations.

- 1** Where have you seen “a form of godliness but denying its power” (v. 5) — in culture, or if you're honest, in yourself?
- 2** Of the loves named in vv. 2–5 — love of self, love of money, love of pleasure — which one do you feel the strongest pull toward right now?
- 3** Paul says everyone who wants to live a godly life “will” be persecuted — not might. Has that truth surprised you, discouraged you, or steadied you? Why?
- 4** What spiritual roots — practices, rhythms, habits in the Word — are underdeveloped in your life right now, leaving you exposed in a storm?
- 5** Where have you quietly retreated from a relationship, conversation, or role because faith got costly? What would re-engaging that actually look like this week — and are you willing to do it?
