[Collosians 3:15-17]

15 "Let the peace of Christ [the inner calm of one who walks daily with Him] be the controlling factor in your hearts [deciding and settling questions that arise]. To this peace indeed you were called as members in one body [of believers]. And be thankful [to God always].....

¹⁶ Let the [spoken] word of Christ have its home within you [dwelling in your heart and mind—permeating every aspect of your being] as you teach [spiritual things] and admonish and train one another with all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs with thankfulness in your hearts to God

The prescription for our ailment "The Battle Within"

[Romans 7:25]

" 25 Thanks be to God [for my deliverance/victory] through Jesus Christ our Lord!" Amp

SEVEN REALITIES OF [Rom. 7] THAT EVERY FOLLOWER OF CHRIST EXPERIENCES:

- I. Sin is a Perplexing Mystery
- **II. Sin is a Total Contradiction To The New Nature**
- III. Sin is a Legal Offense Against The Word of God
- IV. Sin is an Indwelling Force
- V. Sin is a Contrary Power To The New Nature
- VI. Sin is a Competing Evil
- VII. Sin is a Remaining Reality

II. Sin is a Total Contradiction (Rom. 7:15) "15 For I do not understand my own actions [I am baffled and bewildered by them]. I do not practice what I want to do, but I am doing the very thing I hate [and yielding to my human nature, my worldliness—my sinful capacity]."

- A. There is both a negative and a positive aspect to this inverted dilemma.....

 He commits both sins of omission and commission which breed 'transmission and permission"
 - Sins of omission are what he does not dobut should have done.
 - Sins of commission are what he does but should not have done.

A. Know Yourself [Lam. 3:40], "Let us examine our ways and test them, and let us return to the Lord."

Amp

With the knowledge of God comes the knowledge of self.....

- Until you know who God is, you will never know who you are.
- And until you know who you are, you will never advance in spirituality.

[Ps. 139:14)

"I will give thanks and praise to You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Wonderful are Your works, And my soul knows it very well."

II. Sin is a Remaining Reality in the life of every believer.

(Rom. 7:20)

²⁰But if I am doing the very thing I do not want to do, I am no longer the one doing it [that is, it is not me that acts], but the sin [nature] which lives in me.." Amp

"LIVING THANKFUL" BRINGS PERSPECTIVE AND CLARITY

(Col. 3:15-17)

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[of believers]. And be thankful [to God always]....

16 ...Let the [spoken] word of Christ have its home within you [dwelling in your heart and mind—permeating every aspect of your being] as you teach [spiritual things] and admonish and train one another with all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs with thankfulness in your hearts to God ...

17 ... Whatever you do [no matter what it is] in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus [and in dependence on Him], giving thanks to God the Father through Him." Amp

"LIVING THANKFUL" BRINGS CLARITY

- It unclogs the obstructions in the conduit that connects you and I to God- the created, to the Creator.
- It quiets the constant ambient noise that keeps you, the called, from hearing God's voice.

• [Ps. 100], ¹ Shout for joy to the LORD, all the earth. ²Worship the LORD with gladness; come before him with joyful songs. ³ Know that the LORD is God. It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, the sheep of his pasture. 4 Enter His gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to Him and praise His name. 5 For the LORD is good and His love endures forever; His

faithfulness continues through all generations."

[Ps. 106:1], Praise the Lord! (Hallelujah!) Oh give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; For His mercy and lovingkindness endure forever!"

[2 Cor. 2:14], ¹⁴ But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumph in Christ..."

[1 Thess. 5:16-18], ¹⁶ Rejoice always and delight in your faith; 17 be unceasing and persistent in prayer; 18 in every situation [no matter what the circumstances] be thankful and continually give thanks to God; for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus." Amp

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
