(John 20:30,31), *“There are also many other signs (attesting [clear evidence] miracles) that Jesus performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book;*



(Jn 10:10), *“The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows].”*

SIX(6) PRINCIPLES FOR ACTIVATING THE MIRACULOUS POWER OF GOD IN YOUR LIFE."

- 1. Name Your Miracle-***Focus on one thing you need from the Lord.*
- 2. Request Your Miracle-***Prayer is the necessary ingredient that gets things moving in the Spirit realm.*
- 3. Confess Your Miracle-***Say the same thing about your miracle that God is saying to you.*



4. Prepare For Your Miracle-*As you wait for the manifestation of your miracle, learn to respect the tension that exists between “the now,” and “the not-yet.”*

5. Remove All Doubt-*Protect yourself from the influence of people who do not share your faith in God’s ability to act on your behalf.*

6. Trust The Lord-*When you can’t see God’s hand, trust in His plan for your life.*

I. NAME YOUR MIRACLE: Focus on one thing you need from the Lord. Your Faith and Obedience Position you to receive!!!

[Matthew 20:29-34], *“As they were leaving Jericho, a large crowd followed Him.*

³⁰ And two blind men were sitting by the road, and when they heard that Jesus was passing by, they cried out, “Lord, have mercy on us, Son of David (Messiah)!”

³¹ The crowd sternly told them to be quiet, but they cried out all the more, “Lord, Son of David (Messiah) have mercy on us!”

II. REQUEST YOUR MIRACLE: Prayer is the necessary ingredient that gets things moving in the Spirit realm.

[1 John 5:14-15], “This is the [remarkable degree of] confidence which we [as believers are entitled to] have before Him: that [if we ask anything according to His will, [that is, consistent with His plan and purpose] He hears us.


*15 And if we know [for a fact, as indeed we do] that He hears and listens to us in whatever we ask, we [also] know [with settled and absolute knowledge] that we have [granted to us] the requests which we have asked from Him.” **Amp***



[John 11], “A man named Lazarus was sick. He lived in Bethany with his sisters, Mary and Martha.

2 This is the Mary who later poured the expensive perfume on the Lord’s feet and wiped them with her hair. Her brother, Lazarus, was sick.

3 So the two sisters sent a message to Jesus telling him, “Lord, your dear friend is very sick...”

7 Finally, He said to His disciples, “Let’s go back to Judea.....

11 Then He said, “Our friend Lazarus has fallen asleep, but now I will go and wake him up.”

12 The disciples said, “Lord, if he is sleeping, he will soon get better!”

13 They thought Jesus meant Lazarus was simply sleeping, but Jesus meant Lazarus had died.

14 So He told them plainly, “Lazarus is dead. 15 And for your sakes, I’m glad I wasn’t there, for now you will really believe. Come, let’s go see him....”

17 When Jesus arrived at Bethany, He was told that Lazarus had already been in his grave for four days.

20 When Martha got word that Jesus was coming, she went to meet him. But Mary stayed in the house.

21 Martha said to Jesus, “Lord, if only you had been here, my brother would not have died.

22 But even now I know that God will give You whatever you ask.”

31 When the people who were at the house consoling Mary saw her leave so hastily, they assumed she was going to Lazarus's grave to weep. So they followed her there.

32 When Mary arrived and saw Jesus, she fell at his feet and said, "Lord, if only you had been here, my brother would not have died.


33 When Jesus saw her weeping and saw the other people wailing with her, a deep anger welled up within him,[f] and he was deeply troubled.

34 “Where have you put him?” He asked them.

39 “Roll the stone aside,” Jesus told them. But Martha, the dead man’s sister, protested, “Lord, he has been dead for four days. The smell will be terrible.

40 Jesus responded, “Didn’t I tell you that you would see God’s glory if you believe?”

41 So they rolled the stone aside. Then Jesus looked up to heaven and said, “Father, thank you for hearing me.
