Fair Fighting Rules

- No degrading language.
- Discuss the issue, not the person.
- No put-downs,
- swearing, or
- name-calling.
- Degrading language is an attempt to express negative feelings while making sure your partner feels just as bad. This will just lead to more character attacks while the original issue is forgotten.

Ephesians 6:12-13 AMP

12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood [contending only with physical opponents], but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this [present] darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly (supernatural) places.

► 13 Therefore, put on the complete armor of God, so that you will be able to [successfully] resist and stand your ground in the evil day [of danger],

2 Corinthians 10:4-5 AMP

- ► 4 The weapons of our warfare are <u>not physical</u> [weapons of <u>flesh and blood</u>]. Our weapons are <u>divinely powerful</u> for the destruction of fortresses. (a place of defense and protection against large scale attacks.)
- ► 5 We are destroying sophisticated arguments (systems that are complex and tough to understand, thorough and well worked out. Strategic) and every exalted and proud thing that sets itself up against the [true] knowledge of God, and we are taking every thought and purpose captive to the obedience of Christ,

- Band of truth

- Breastplate of righteousness(an upright heart)

- He who walks with integrity, and works righteousness, And speaks truth in his heart

- Strapped feet with Peace (firm-footed stability and the readiness produced by the good news)

- 15 but in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect,

- Sword of the Spirit (Word of God) Weapon
- Hebrews 4:12
- For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.
- Prayer-Infuses the rest of our armor with power needed to fight the enemy.
- Ephesians 6:18
- 18 And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people.
- ► WOrship-Shifts your focus and your mindset. When we begin to remember who God is in the midst of the darkness. Worship reminds us of what God can do,
- Deuteronomy 10:21
- 21 He is the one you praise; he is your God, who performed for you those great and awesome wonders you saw with your own eyes.

- ► The Name of Jesus- Power to overcome the powers of darkness.
- Philippians 2:9-11
- -Therefore, God exalted him to the highest place
- and gave him the name that is above every name,
- 10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow,
- in heaven and on earth and under the earth,
- 11 and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord,
- to the glory of God, the Father.
- Fasting A time to turn down our plate as we humble ourselves before God and seek his face. Fasting helps us hear from God.
- Isaiah 58:6-7
- 6 "Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen:
- to loose the chains of injustice
- and untile the cords of the yoke,
- to set the oppressed free
- and break every yoke?
- 7 Is it not to share your food with the hungry
 - and to provide the poor wanderer with shelter—
- when you see the naked, to clothe them,
 - and not to turn away from your own flesh and blood?

- **Our Testimony-** gives way for faith to build and hope to rise. Our testimony brings confidence and belief in the God of our salvation.

- 11 They triumphed over him

- Thankfulness according to the Bible is not just an act of the will, it's a posture of the heart.

- My secure and eternal future in heaven with my Heavenly Father
- Thanksgiving is a weapon against <u>arrogance</u>-a soil in which pride does not easily grow."
- Psalm 7:17
- "I will give to the Lord the thanks due to his righteousness, and I will sing praise to the name of the Lord, the Most High."

- Thanksgiving is a weapon against <u>anxiety-</u>We have constant reminders put before us about the things we don't have but could have.
- Philippians 4:6-7
- * "6 do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. 7 And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
- Thankfulness shifts our focus from what we lack to what we have.
- Thankfulness shifts our focus from what could be, to what is and what will be.
