- 7. Who is going to be feed the women?
  - a. This is symbolic of two things.
    - 1. First Just as the lord feed the people of Israel in the wildness with manna So will he provide food for those who flee to Petra.

- Exodus 16:31 (NKJV)

  31 And the house of Israel called its name Manna. And it *was* like white coriander seed, and the taste of it was like wafers made with honey.

# **Revelation 12:6 (NKJV)**

- <sup>6</sup> Then the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, that they should feed her there one thousand two hundred and sixty days.
  - c. But I believe that you will see the fleeing start at the beginning of the first three and one halfyear.
    - 1. First a trickle and then a flood.
- 9. At this time there will be two ruling Government.
  - a. The ruling Government of the Jews.
  - b. The ruling Government of the antichrist.

- 10. We must remember the peace treaty the antichrist makes with the nation of Israel at the beginning of the tribulation.
  - 1. Which will be broken half way through the seven years or at midterm.

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- a. The antichrist will have trouble securing the loyalty of everyone.
  - 1. From the believing Jews.
  - 2. To those who will refuse to take the mark of the beast.
- b. Two things will happen to those who refuse to take the mark of the beast.
  - 1. They will be killed –(beheaded) by the millions or imprisoned by the millions and Tortured.
    - a. This will be the world greatest Holocaust.
  - 2. The believing jews will flee to Petra.

  - a. The beginning of sorrows
  - b. The abomination of desolation.

# **Daniel 9:27 (KJV)**

- And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make *it* desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.
  - a. (K.J. and for the over spreading)
    He shall make it desolate.
  - b. (N.K.J And on the wings of abomination).

    Daniel 9:27 (NKJV)
- Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; But in the middle of the weekHe shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one whomakes desolate, Even until the consummation, which is determined, Is poured out on the desolate
  - c. Shall be one who makes desolate.
    - 1. The meaning of the statement is Upon the wings of the desolator the time will come that the one who will make the desolation will come.

      or he will appear. And take away the Sacrifices, or the privilege to sacrifice, will be taken away.

### **Daniel 12:11 (KJV)**

- And from the time *that* the daily *sacrifice* shall be taken away, and the abomination that maketh desolate set up, *there shall be* a thousand two hundred and ninety days.

  Daniel 12:11 (NKJV)
- And from the time *that* the daily *sacrifice* is taken away, and the abomination of desolation is set up, *there shall be* one thousand two hundred and ninety days.
  - d. Meaning this the desolation of abomination must happen somewhere at the middle of the tribulations.
    - 1. In other words at the halfway point.
    - 2. Which we believe is at the end of chapter nine.
  - e. In other words this is when the antichrist is revealed.
    - 1. And when Satan appears himself to take over.

# **Revelation 12:7 (NKJV)**

- <sup>7</sup> And war broke out in heaven: Michael and his angels fought with the dragon; and the dragon and his angels fought,
  - a. This war is a heavenly war.
    - 1. First this means it is a war fought in heaven.
      - a. Meaning its not one fought in the nation of Israel itself yet.
      - b. There will be a war fought on the ground but this one is not it.
    - 2. Secondly it's a war fought over the nation of Israel.
      - a. Meaning It's the last war fought for the nation of Israel.
      - b. Meaning It's a war fought for the souls of believers.
- 14. These verse gave John readers a glimpse of who's causing these struggles and war.
  - a. There are two key players in this war in the heavens.
    - 1. The arch angel Michales and his angles.
    - 2. Satan and his fallen angels.

    - 4. Those who are killed by any means during the tribulation will never have the opportunity to be saved.
- 22. When the war ends Satan will be cast out of heaven his finale time.
  - a. Meaning he will not have access to heaven any longer.
  - b. Meaning Satan has access to heaven now but that access will come to a end forever.
