#### **Revelation 12:7 (NKJV)**

- <sup>7</sup> And war broke out in heaven: Michael and his angels fought with the dragon; and the dragon and his angels fought,
  - a. This war is a heavenly war.
    - 1. First this means it is a war fought in heaven.
      - a. Meaning it's not one fought in the nation of Israel itself yet.
      - b. There will be a war fought on the ground but this one is not it.
    - 2. Secondly it's a war fought over the nation of Israel.
      - a. Meaning It's the last war fought for the nation of Israel.
      - b. Meaning It's a war fought for the souls of believers.
  - b. It's a war fought many years ago that is also on going until the end.
    - 1. We must be careful not to be mislead about scripture.
    - 2. Because if this is a new war then we have trouble explaining the war fought in heaven in the book of Isiash.
    - 3. Scripture never speaks about another war in heaven, only one.
    - 4. But we know also that it's an on-going war with good and evil. Paul makes this very clear in the book of Ephesians.

### **Ephesians 6:10-13 (KJV)**

- Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.
- 11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.
- <sup>12</sup> For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.
- Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.
- 11. These verses gave John's readers a glimpse of who's causing these struggles and war.
  - a. There are two key players in this war in the heavens.
    - 1. The arch angel Michael and his angles.
    - 2. Satan and his fallen angels.

- 12. Scripture teaches us that God has placed angles to
  - a. Watch over all believers.
  - b. To protect all believers.
  - c. Fight battles that believers can't see or fight.

Heb. 1:1-14

- 13. Scripture teaches us that there are different ranks and rankings of angles.
  - a. Paul teaches us that our warfare is against many different ranks of evil.

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Eph. 6:10-12 - Rom. 8:38-39 - Eph. 1:21 - Eph. 3:10
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b. The Hebrew writer speaks of the ranking of angels.

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Heb. 1:1-14
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- 14. The arch angel Michael is seen as many different things.
  - a. As the angel of God the top-ranking angel.
  - b. As the servant of God.
  - c. As the warrior of God.
  - d. The guardian angel for believers.
  - e. As the administrator for God.

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Dan. 10:21 - Dan. 12:1-12 - 1Thess. 4:16 - Jude 6
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- 15. Michael and his angels struggle or war is against Satan and his fallen angles.
  - a. It's a war that has been fought.
  - b. John tells us two things about this war.
    - 1. Where it was fought in heaven
    - 2. When it was fought many years ago in heaven.

c. It is a battle that is on going until the end.

16. The arch angel Michael is mentioned five times in scripture.

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Dan. 10:13 - Dan. 10:21 - Dan. 12:1 - Jude 9 - Rev. 12:7
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- a. Every time you see the arch angel Michael, He will be doing two things.
  - 1. First He will be in a battle or making war.
  - 2. Secondly He will be contending for or connected to the nation of Israel.
- b. This is why he is called the prince of Israel.

## **Daniel 12:1 (KJV)**

<sup>1</sup> And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation *even* to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book.

17. Satan himself is an angel and also has many warriors.

Rev. 12:7

a. Satan knows his time is short

#### **Revelation 12:12 (NKJV)**

- <sup>12</sup> Therefore rejoice, O heavens, and you who dwell in them! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and the sea! For the devil has come down to you, having great wrath, because he knows that he has a short time."
- 18. Satan's war has three battle fronts or three battle agendas.
  - a. The Jews.
  - b. The gentiles who have not believed.
  - c. Also against every believer that has ever called upon the name of the Lord Jesus Christ for salvation by faith.
- 19. There will be three stages of the demise of the Satan and his followers.
  - a. First- Their first demise was when they were cast out of third heaven.

Is. 14; 12 - 14

b. Secondly - Their second demise will be when they are cast out from this earth and locked in chains for a thousand years.

11 Pet. 2:4

c. Thirdly – Their third and final demise will be when they are cast into the lake of fire for eternity

#### Revelation 20:10 (KJV)

And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet *are*, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

- 20. The war that Satan wages will have a three-fold meaning and purpose.
  - a. First to steal, kill, destroy and hope of those who are lost.
  - b. Secondly to stop any and all from
    - 1. Receiving Christ.
    - 2. The witness for Christ.
    - 3. The testimony of Christ.
    - 4. Those who are killed by any means during the tribulation will never have the opportunity to be saved.
  - c. Third To stop or foul any and all prophecy.
    - 1. Why?
      - a. Because if he can prevent any thing that God has said in His word from coming true are from coming to pass.
      - b. Then he can prove God is not the real and true God.
      - c. That God is not the ultimate God.
- 21. When the war ends, Satan will be cast out of heaven his finale time.
  - a. Meaning He will not have access to heaven any longer.
  - b. Meaning Satan has access to heaven now, but that access will come to a end forever.

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Job 1:1-16 - Eph. 6; 12 - Luke 10:18
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22. All heavenly wars will come to an end with good and evil.

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Dan. 10:14 - Dan. 12:1
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a. Except for the last battle with Satan at the end of the one thousand millennial reign.

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Rev. 20:7 - 10
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- 23. God has angels who do His battling.
  - a. Notice God does not fight His battles.
  - b. His angles do.

- Revelation 12:7 (KJV)

  And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels,
- b. They are God.
  - 1. Sent
  - 2. Empowered
  - 3. Deployed to do God work
  - c. God does not have to dirty His hands with such small things as the devil and his fallen angel.
  - d. Just as then, as also now God prevails over Satan.
