 1. But also it is speaking of a place of refuge for the believing Jews only.

11. The place is called Petra.

Daniel 9:27 (KJV)

²⁷ And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make *it* desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

- a. (K.J. and for the over spreading)
He shall make it desolate.
- b. (N.K.J And on the wings of abomination).

Daniel 9:27 (NKJV)

²⁷ Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; But in the middle of the week He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one whomakes desolate, Even until the consummation, which is determined, Is poured out on the desolate

- c. Shall be one who makes desolate.
 1. The meaning of the statement is – Upon the wings of the desolator the time will come that the one who will make the desolation will come.
or he will appear. And take away the Sacrifices, or the privilege to sacrifice, will be taken away.

¹¹ And from the time *that* the daily *sacrifice* is taken away, and the abomination of desolation is set up, *there shall be* one thousand two hundred and ninety days.

- d. Meaning this the desolation of abomination must happen somewhere at the middle of the tribulations.
 1. In other words at the halfway point.
 2. Which we believe is at the end of chapter nine.
- e. In other words this is when the antichrist is revealed.
 1. And when Satan appears himself to take over.
