7. John hears the great rejoicing of the long-awaited reunion of the saints.

Revelation 19:1-4 (NKJV)

¹ After these things I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, "Alleluia! Salvation and glory and honor and power *belong* to the Lord our God!

² For true and righteous *are* His judgments, because He has judged the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication; and He has avenged on her the blood of His servants *shed* by her." ³ Again they said, "Alleluia! Her smoke rises up forever and ever!" ⁴ And the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God who sat on the throne, saying, "Amen! Alleluia!"

a. First, John says he hears a loud multitude of voice coming from heaven which gives us four understandings.

1. First – The rejoicing over the destruction of Babylon or the empire of evil.

2. Secondly – The celebration giving honor and glory to the lamb of God.

a. Its voice of praise and worship

b. Its voices of honor to the Lord Jesus Christ for,

1. His salvation – Ps. 37 : 39 – 11 Cor. 9 : 15 - 1 Pet. 2 : 9

2. His deliverance – 11 Cor. 9 : 15

3. His faithfulness – Isaiah 12 : 2 – Isaiah 25 : 9

3. Third – It's the rejoicing of the long-awaited execution of His righteous judgments.

4. Fourth - John says the praise continues to Glorify the Lord Jesus Christ for His victory over,

a. The harlot and all who took the mark of the beast.

b. Those who shed the blood of the saints

1. The word Alleluia gets its origins from a Hebrew word 239 which means to praise or give honor – to adore – or to rave or sing in celebration as in a marriage or wedding.

a. The word is taken from two Hebrew words

1. The word Halal – which means praise and Jah which is name of God-(Jehovah). which says, praise Jehovah.

c. The first Alleluia in verse one points back to the destruction of the judgment of the harlot in chapter sixteen through chapter eighteen.

d. The second Alleluia points forward to the anticipation of coming wedding celebration of the Lamb.

1. This is where we get our marriage supper of the lamb.

Revelation 19:9 (NKJV)

⁹ Then he said to me, "Write: 'Blessed *are* those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!' " And he said to me, "These are the true sayings of God."

8. The celebration is not for something to happen but yet for something that has happened.

a. John says the announcement says, it has come-(or is time for it).

Revelation 19:7 (NKJV)

⁷ Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb **has come**, and His wife has made herself ready."

b. The Lord Jesus Christ has been triumph over His enemies.

1. He has destroyed the ungodly political and religious system of the world.

2. He has avenged those who have been persecuted and abused and murdered by this evil reign.

3. He has returned to earth and destroyed the armies of Armageddon.

4. He has restored His righteous rule here upon earth.

Phil. 2 : 9 – 11 – Col. 1 : 12 – Rev. 11 : 17 – Ps. 35 : 28 -

c. There could be not celebration as long as there is work of evil to be dealt with.

1. This is very important to know because of what verses 17 – 21 says.

9. John says those who are rejoicing declare that the smoke from her destruction will be seen forever.

Revelation 19:3 (NKJV)

³ Again they said, "Alleluia! Her smoke rises up forever and ever!"

a. Which means it will be permanent and everlasting.

1. Destruction has already happened.

b. The smoke does not reflect a everlasting visible smoke but more of a symbolic smoke which should be as a reminder of God everlasting judgment upon evil.

c. We should know that smoke could not be a visible everlasting smoke because there will be a New Heaven and a new earth which would not allow such thing so we must know it's more of a symbolic understanding of God everlasting judgment, one to be in the minds of those who love God for ever and ever.

10. The marriage supper of the Lamb is the ultimate celebration put on by God for His son in heaven. –(not here on earth as some teach).

[Luke 14 : 1 - 35](#)

a. First – It portrays the ultimate reunion of Old and New Testament saints along with those martyred during the first part of the seven-year tribulations,

b. Key details

1. It's a reunion of the Lamb of God and His church-(Bride).

2. Its signifies the end of God redemptive History.

3. Its symbolic of God complete victory over evil

4. Its symbolic of God eternal communion with His believers

c. Its guess list.

1. The bridegroom – The Lord Jesus Christ

a. Who is this heavenly escort scripture does not say.

1. He is only identified by being equal to John

a. Just a servant

b. John servant

c. A brethren who has the testimony of Jesus.
