8. John host says he has the testimony of the Jesus and tells John to worship God and not Him.

Revelation 19:10 (NKJV)

¹⁰ And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "*See that you do not do that! I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.*"

a. The word testimony means – witness or witnessing which has nothing to do with a verbal statement of faith, but yet ones testimony of a changed life lived as a testimony of their faith.

11 Cor. 5 : 17 - Act. 9 : 1 – 16 – John 3 : 3 – Rev. 14 – 13 – Rev. 12 : 11

b. Witness or witnessing is the identifying mark of a true believer in three ways.

1. First – One is converted or convinced of the truth of the Lord Jesus Christ.

1 John 5 : 10 – 13 - John 3 : 16 - John 16 : 8 – 9

John 11 : 25 - 26 – John 14 : 6 – Luke 24 : 27

2. Secondly – By ones conviction so he lives his Life.

Act 3 : 19 – John 3 : 3 – Luke 9 : 23 – 26 – Matt. 28 : 19 – 20

Act 1 : 7 – 8 – 11 Pet. 1 : 2 - 4

3. Thirdly – That all scripture points to (or Prophecy of)- the Lord Jesus Christ.-(No other God). Exodus 20 : 1 – 5 – Eph. 4 : 1 – 6

Gen. 3 : 14- 16 - Matt. 1 : 22 – 25 - Col. 3 : 1 – 4

Phil. 3 : 9 – 11 - Heb. 12 : 2

a. Or the Spirit of Prophecy meaning - The Holy Spirit reveals the truth of prophecy –(or of scripture)- which is the Lord Jesus Christ.

I Pet. 1 – 10 – 11 – 11 Pet. 2 : 17 : 21

9. John sees the heavens open up.

Revelation 19:11 (NKJV)

¹¹ Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him *was* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war.

a. This verse gives us clues to what's happened.

1. First - John sees the heavens open and sees the Lord Jesus Christ sitting upon a great white Horse.

a. As we know is symbolic of a great entrance into a city because by a great conqueror and a great battle won –(not to be fought but won).

2. Secondly – John gives clear detail of the one who sits on the great white horse.-(leaving no doubt of who it is).
(It is the Lord Jesus Christ Himself).
(He is called the word of God)

John 1:1-3 (NKJV)

¹ In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

² He was in the beginning with God.

³ All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

a. He is faithful and true and in righteousness- meaning clothed in all of His honors.

1. Faithful and true is to be understood as a title.

Psalms 96:13 (NKJV)

¹³ For He is coming, for He is coming to judge the earth. He shall judge the world with righteousness, And the peoples with His truth.

3. Thirdly – He judges, which are true and righteous judgments.

4. Fourth – He makes war – against the evils of this world.

a. From His mouth goes judgment.

Revelation 19:13-16 (NKJV)

5. Fifth - John says the armies in heaven follow Him on white horse themselves.

a. The understanding is one of legions standing by if needed.

Matthew 26:53 (NKJV)

⁵³ Or do you think that I cannot now pray to My Father, and He will provide Me with more than twelve legions of angels?

b. The wedding is over, War has begun.

6. Sixth – John says. He himself treads the winepress of fierceness and wrath of almighty God.

a. Meaning – Carries out the judgments of God

Isaiah 63 : 1 - 19 - Gen. 49 : 9 - 11

b. To tread means to bring judgment.

10. John says he sees a angel standing in the sun.

Revelation 19:17-20 (NKJV)

¹⁷ Then I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in the midst of heaven, "Come and gather together for the supper of the great God,
¹⁸ that you may eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all *people*, free and slave, both small and great." ¹⁹ And I saw the beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army. ²⁰ Then the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image.

- a. The angel calls all the birds of the air to a supper-(or feast).
given to them by a great God who takes care of all the birds of the air.

Matt. 6 : 25 – 34

- 1. Ezekial prophesied about the coming of the birds
Eze. 39 – 17 - 29
- 2. The purpose of this great supper or feast is to clean up the dead left over from the great Armageddon battel.
- 3. Over 200 million men were destroyed in one day at one battel.

Rev. 9 : 15 - Rev. 16 : 12 - 16 – Rev. 17 : 14

- a. But also the antichrist and his false prophets and their reign were all defeated in one hour of one day.
- b. Also along with them the wicked of this earth will all be destroyed.

Revelation 17:14 (NKJV)

¹⁴ These will make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, for He is Lord of lords and King of kings; and those *who are* with Him *are* called, chosen, and faithful."

11. The great day of the Lord has happened the armies of the world have been destroyed just as the prophet Ezekiel predicted many years earlier.

Eze. 39 : 1- 1 - 20

- a. This great supper is not liken to the marriage supper and its invited guest this supper guest or the fowl of the air
- b. The fowl were filled with the remains of their flesh.

Revelation 19:21 (NKJV)

²¹ And the rest were killed with the sword which proceeded from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse. And all the birds were filled with their flesh.

12. John says there are two who are cast into the Lake of fire.

- a. The beast – The antichrist – the one who sold his soul to Satan for the kingdoms of this world.
- b. The False prophet – The religious leader who mislead the world into worship of the beast and institute the mark of the beast.
