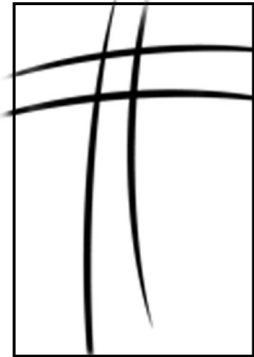
Allowing Calamity to Cultivate Compassion
