Matt. 5:5 Blessed are the meek, For they shall **inherit** the earth.

Matt. 19:29 And everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, for My name's sake, shall receive a hundredfold, and **inherit** eternal life.

Matt. 25:34 Then the King will say to those on His right hand, "Come, you blessed of My Father, **inherit** the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

Eph. 1:11 In Him also we have obtained an **inheritance**, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will,

Eph. 1:18 the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His **inheritance** in the saints,

Heb. 1:14 Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will **inherit** salvation?

Heb. 6:12 that you do not become sluggish, but imitate those who through faith and patience **inherit** the promises.

Heb. 9:15 And for this reason He is the Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.

Heb. 11:7 By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became **heir** of the righteousness which is according to faith.

1Pet. 3:7 Husbands, likewise, dwell with *them* with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as *being* heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered.

Rev. 21:7 He who overcomes shall **inherit** all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son.
