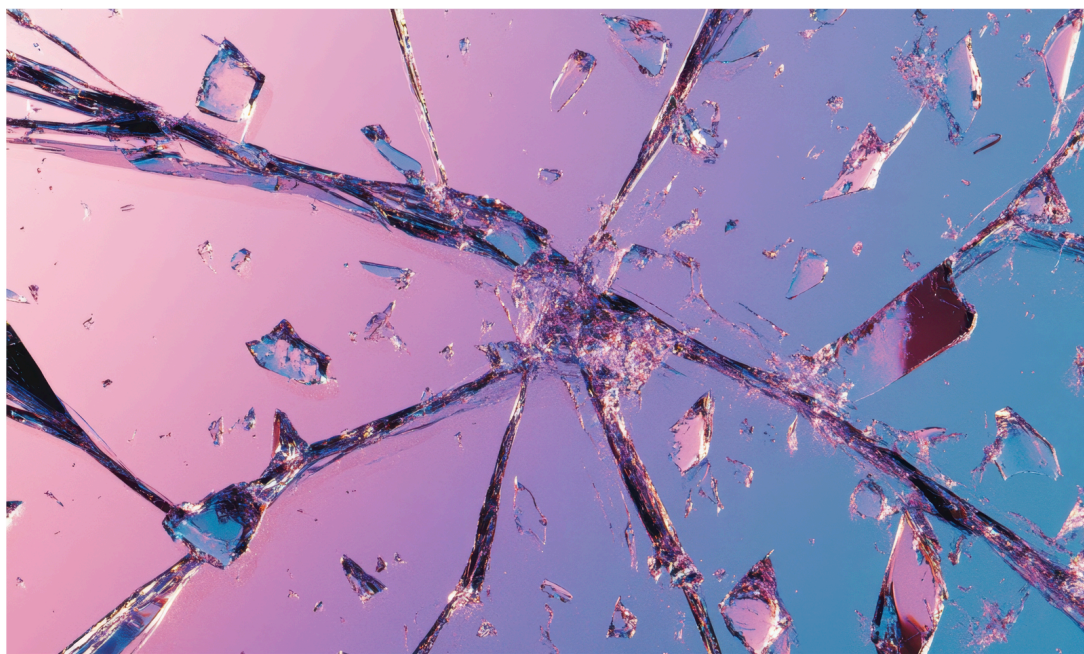

GETTING ACQUAINTED



Margery Rich - The Story Whisperer

Margery was born in Glendale to Harold and Mary Lou Rich, a new Seventh-day Adventist pastor and his recently converted wife. At five, the family moved to Hawai'i, where she enjoyed a "free-range childhood" amid natural beauty. Far from extended family, her faith was shaped by her father's devotion and her mother's guidance, especially after the death of her beloved grandmother.

With three younger brothers, the household was lively, full of chores, meals, and Sabbath routines. Returning to Southern California for academy, Margery discovered a calling to serve God and a love for English, earning her master's and teaching credential at Andrews University before returning to California, after several snowy winters!

She taught for over forty years in Adventist academies, mainly at San Gabriel Academy. Her parents retired to Walla Walla, passing away in 2015 and 2020, and her brothers settled in Washington State.

Retiring during the pandemic, Margery rediscovered her passions for writing, puzzles, and drawing. Personal growth coaching helped her understand herself, her faith, and how to help others move past limiting stories.

She found her true calling as a Story Whisperer, guiding people to recognize and reshape the stories that shape their lives. At Glendale City Church, she shares this through *The Living Project: "Telling My Story. Listening to Your Story. Living Our Story."* These days, she continues writing, drawing, and coaching others—and sometimes herself—to uncover and reshape the stories that shape their lives.

"Now," says Margery. "I 'work' on my novel, but there's more 'play' than work in it. I use drawings along with some of my exploratory essays on all kinds of topics. Unpublished so far, but who knows? As a Story Whisperer coach, I help people—including myself sometimes! —figure out what story "program" is running unconsciously, and how to shift it to another direction. I still believe God wants me to be "useful," and it's okay to be "happy," but WOW! God's world for me now is so much bigger and better than it ever was before!"
