greatness!

**praise** him with lute and harp!

<sup>4</sup> **Praise** him with tambourine and dance;

**praise** him with strings and pipe!

<sup>5</sup> **Praise** him with sounding cymbals;

**praise** him with loud clashing cymbals!

<sup>6</sup> Let everything that has breath **praise** the LORD! **Praise** the LORD! (**Psa 150:1**)

## Praise the Lord!

1. Praise God everywhere (vv. 1-2).
2. Praise Him for his deeds and greatness (v. 2).
3. Express your praise to the Lord (vv. 3-5).

# 1. Praise God Everywhere (v. 1).

**Praise** the LORD!

**Praise** God in his sanctuary;

**praise** him in his mighty heavens!

Praise the Lord in:

- i. His Sanctuary (Rev 7:9-12; 1Co 3:16-17).
- ii. His mighty Heavens (Ps 19:1; Col 1:16).
- iii. Praise God everywhere!

I **praise Jesus!**  
I do! I **praise him**, Sam-I-am!

And I would **praise him** in a boat!  
And I would **praise him** with a goat...

## Praise God because of his:

**Mighty Deeds**

- Tell someone about God.
- Share your story.

**Excellent  
Greatness**

- Recall his attributes.
- Praise him for his power.

Christmas is the mightiest of deeds!

“But the angel said to them, ‘Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord” (Luke 2:10-11).

### 3. Express your praise (vv. 3-5).
