
A Song of Praise

Psalm 145



What should my praise look like?

- i. Continual Praise.
- ii. Vocal Praise.
- iii. God-focused Praise.

Big Idea: Praise flows from knowing God; so, I draw near to the Lord and praise him through the storms.

A Song of Praise. Of David. I will extol you, my God and King, and bless your name forever and ever. ² Every day I will bless you and praise your name forever and ever. ³ Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised, and his greatness is unsearchable. ⁴ One generation shall commend your works to another, and shall declare your mighty acts. ⁵ On the glorious splendor of your majesty, and on your wondrous works, I will meditate. ⁶ They shall speak of the might of your awesome deeds, and I will declare your greatness. ⁷ They shall pour forth the fame of your abundant goodness and shall sing aloud of your righteousness.

¹⁵ The eyes of all look to you, and you give them their food in due season. ¹⁶ You open your hand; you satisfy the desire of every living thing. ¹⁷ The LORD is righteous in all his ways and kind in all his works. ¹⁸ The LORD is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth. ¹⁹ He fulfills the desire of those who fear him; he also hears their cry and saves them. ²⁰ The LORD preserves all who love him, but all the wicked he will destroy. ²¹ My mouth will speak the praise of the LORD, and let all flesh bless his holy name forever and ever. (Psa 145:1-21 ESV).

Big Idea: Praise flows from knowing God; so, I draw near to the Lord and praise him through the storms.

Praise God because:

- 1. You know him (vv. 1-7).
- 2. God's love abounds (vv. 8-9).
- 3. His kingdom is glorious (vv. 10-13).
- 4. He is generous (vv. 14-16)
- 5. His graciousness (vv. 17-21).

1. Praise God because you know him (1-7).

A Song of Praise. Of David. - 4 Ways to praise God today.
- i. Tell/speak/declare God's greatness (vv. 4, 6).
- ii. Meditate on His glory (v. 5).
- iii. Make Jesus famous (v. 7a).
- iv. Sing aloud of His righteousness (v. 7b).

2. God's love abounds (8-9).

⁸ The LORD is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. ⁹ The LORD is good to all, and his mercy is over all that he has made. (vv. 8-9; cf. Ex 34:6)

3. His kingdom is good (10-13).

¹⁰ All your works shall give thanks to you, O LORD, and all your saints shall bless you! ¹¹ They shall speak of the glory of your kingdom and tell of your power, ¹² to make known to the children of man your mighty deeds, and the glorious splendor of your kingdom. ¹³ Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and your dominion endures throughout all generations. The LORD is faithful in all his works.

4. He is generous (14-16).

¹⁴ The <u>LORD upholds</u> all who are falling and raises up all who are bowed down. ¹⁵ The eyes of all look to you, and <u>you give</u> them their food in due season. ¹⁶ <u>You open</u> your hand; <u>you satisfy</u> the desire of every living thing.

5. He is gracious (17-20).

¹⁷ The <u>LORD is righteous</u> in all his ways and kind in all his works. ¹⁸ The <u>LORD is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth</u>. ¹⁹ He fulfills the desire of those who fear him; he also hears their cry and saves them. ²⁰ The <u>LORD preserves</u> all who love him, but all the wicked he will destroy. (vv. 17-20; cf. Rom 10:9).

²¹ My mouth will speak the praise of the LORD, and let all flesh bless his holy name forever and ever. (v. 21)
