Open Up

Who was someone growing up that made you feel safe? What made you trust them?

Have you ever gotten lost? What happened?

Dig In

Read John 10:1-6

What do you think it means to "know" Jesus' voice? What are some other "voices" competing for our attention today?

Why do you think sheep refuse to follow a stranger? How can we become better at recognizing Jesus' voice?

Read John 10:7-10

What does Jesus mean when He says, "I am the door"?

Why do you think Jesus contrasts Himself with thieves and robbers?

What do you think Jesus means by "life abundantly"? How is abundant life different from what our culture says makes life meaningful?

Read John 10:11-18

What makes Jesus different from the hired hand? Why is it significant that Jesus willingly lays down His life?

Verse 14 says Jesus knows His sheep. How does that encourage you? When have you experienced Jesus' care during a difficult season?

Who are the "other sheep" Jesus is talking about? What does this teach us about God's heart for the nations?

How can our church reflect Jesus' desire for one flock?

Read John 10:19-21

Why do you think Jesus' teaching caused such different reactions? Why do people still disagree about Jesus today?
