



## Conquer | Week 4 Discussion Guide

**Title:** Conquering Love

**Text:** Romans 8:31-39

**Big Idea:** We can live securely in the love of God.

### Open Up

How does our culture define love? Can you give some examples of this?

Who made you feel safe growing up? How did they do that?

### Dig In

*Read Romans 8:31-35*

What point is Paul conveying with these rhetorical questions? Who actually tries to bring charges against the elect?

When was a time that God reminded you (or someone you know) of the love of Christ in the midst of difficulty or distress?

*Read Hebrews 7:25*

In this verse and in Romans 8:34, we are told about Christ's intercession for us. What does this fact teach us about Christ?

*Read Psalm 44:22-26*

Romans 8:36 is a quote from Psalm 44. What point is Paul making in using this Psalm? Do you see the complaint of this Psalm still played out today? If so, how?

*Read Romans 8:37-39*

How does Paul answer the rhetorical questions he presents?

How do we become "more than conquerors"? How do we live this out in our daily lives?

### Close Out

Like Paul, if you are convinced of these things, what effect will this knowledge have on your life?
