### No Mere Mortal

**Bible Text:** John 1:1-18; Genesis 1:1; Colossians 1:15-17; Romans 8:15-17

### Open Up

What is your favorite story about Jesus in the Gospels? How come?

### Dig In

#### Read John 1:1a & Genesis 1:1a

What is the significance of the similarities between these two verses?

What does it mean that Jesus is the *Word*? Why do you think John started out his letter this way?

#### Read John 1:1-3

What are some descriptions of Jesus that clearly point to Him as being God? Which description is most encouraging to you, and why?

#### Read Colossians 1:15-17

What can we learn about Jesus from this passage? What does it mean that “all things were created through him and for him”?

If this world was created for Him, what does that mean for how we live our lives?

#### Read John 1:4-18

Sunday we look at three glorious benefits of a life in Jesus. #1 We live in the light (4-9). #2 We live as children of God (10-13). We experience grace (upon grace) and truth (14-18)

What does it look like to live in the light? How can Christians sometimes still live in darkness?

#### Read Romans 8:15-17

How does the reality that we are God’s children help us deal with fear in our lives? What can we learn from human adoption that can help us understand our relationship with God?

What do you think it means that we have received “grace upon grace?” What are some ways you’ve experienced God’s grace upon grace?
