How does free will lead to both beauty and pain in this world?

Read Isaiah 53:3-5 & Hebrews 4:15-16

Why is it important to know that Jesus also experienced suffering and evil when He walked the earth?

Jesus encountered suffering and evil when He went to the cross. Why is this truth so significant to the issue of suffering and evil?

Read Genesis 50:19-20, Romans 8:28 & 1 Peter 1:3-7

What are some ways that suffering and evil can actually produce good things in our lives? How have you experienced this to be true?

Read 2 Peter 3:8-13

How are these verses helpful as you navigate living in a world with suffering and evil?
