**Bible Text:** John 6:1-21

### Open Up

When have you faced a situation that felt completely beyond your resources or control?

How did you respond?

### Dig In

**God is our PROVIDER. Read John 6:1-15.**

What problem does Jesus present to His disciples? Why do you think He did this? How does God do things like this in our lives sometimes?

How would you describe the differences in faith between Philip, Andrew, and the little boy? Who do you most resemble?

Where do you tend to think like Philip (focused on lack)? What would it look like to respond more like Andrew (bringing what you have to Jesus)?

Like the boy, what “small offering” do you have that God might want to use?

Why is it significant that there were 12 baskets left over?

What lessons do we learn about Jesus from these verses? How is this an encouragement to you?

**God is our POWER. Read John 6:16-21.**

Why might Jesus have waited before coming to them?

What does this miracle reveal about Jesus’ authority?

### Close Out

What “storm” are you currently facing? How do you usually respond—fear or faith?

What’s one action step you can take, or need to take, in light of today’s passages?
