



## Behold The Lamb | Week 9 Study Guide King Jesus (Palm Sunday Sermon)

**Bible Text:** John 12:12-19; Luke 19:41-44; Revelation 19:11-16

### Open Up

Who is the strongest leader you have known or have worked for? What made them such a strong leader?

### Dig In

On Sunday we looked at the triumphal entry of Jesus on Palm Sunday. We reflected on five characteristics of King Jesus. Let's focus on them for this week's study guide. **Read John 12:12-19.**

#### #1 Jesus is a **humble king**

How did the way Jesus entered the city reflect humility? Why do you think this would have been a surprising way for Jesus to enter the city?

How did the life of Jesus reflect humble leadership? What lessons can we learn from this for our own lives?

#### #2 Jesus is a **savior king**

*Hosanna* means "Save now." Read Luke 19:10. What did Jesus come to do? By Thursday the crowd went from cheering Him to crying out "crucify Him." How was their idea of Jesus "saving" them different than His?

How do people today have the wrong idea of who Jesus is and what He's come to do?

#### #3 Jesus is a **praiseworthy king**

While many in the crowd would change their tune about Jesus, they certainly worshipped Him with exuberance on Sunday. Read John 4:23-24. What does it mean to worship in spirit and truth?

Do most people worship Jesus with exuberance on Sunday's? Why or why not? Why does it matter how we worship Jesus?

#### #4 Jesus is a **compassionate king**

Luke includes something the other Gospels don't after Jesus entered the city. Read Luke 19:41-44. How do we see the heart of Jesus in this passage?

What might be some ways we can develop a deep compassion for those far from God? What prevents us from having this kind of heart for the lost?

#### #5 Jesus will be a **conquering king**

The first time Jesus came to earth He came as a sacrificial lamb. At His second coming He will return as a conquering king. Read Revelation 19:11-16. What emotions do these verses evoke in you? How come?

Why is it so important now to remember what Jesus will do later?

Which of the characters of King Jesus did you most need to be reminded of? How come?

What application will you make this week in light of King Jesus being in your life?
