Bible Text: Ecclesiastes 11

Big Idea: What we do on earth will impact our eternity.

Open Up

Can you share a time in your life when you faced uncertainty—whether about your future, a relationship, your health, or something else?

What emotions or doubts did you struggle with at the time? What did you turn to, to rely on?

Dig In

Read Ecclesiastes 11:5-6

How do you typically respond when you're facing an uncertain outcome—do you worry, wait, act, or avoid? Why do you think that is?

What can help us to find peace and patience in those times? What can we do during those periods of waiting to be proactive?

Read Ecclesiastes 11:8-10

How do you think our culture expects the youth to act? What are the youths encouraged to do according to this passage?

Where else in Scripture are Christians commanded to rejoice? Why do you think rejoicing is a major theme throughout Scripture?

How should the call to rejoice impact our lives at home, work, or in worship? How can we find the strength to rejoice in times of uncertainty?

Read Romans 8:35-39

What comfort does God provide in moments of distress? How does his promise of steadfast love provide joy even in times of struggle?

What does it mean to be a conqueror through Christ? How does that impact the way we interact within the world around us?

How can you embrace joy in worship this week? What is one area of your life you can find dependence on God in? How can you live as a conqueror this week?
