**Bible Text:** John 7:53-8:11

### Open Up

Why do you think people are often harsher with others than with themselves?  
When is it hardest to show both truth and grace at the same time?

### Dig In

#### Read John 7:53-8:11

Why do you think the religious leaders were trying to trap Jesus? Why do you think the older accusers left first?

How does Jesus balance grace and truth in this story?

Jesus says, “Neither do I condemn you,” but also says, “Go and sin no more.” Why are both parts important?

What does this story teach us about: hypocrisy? shame? repentance? mercy?

Which person in the story do you relate to most right now: the woman, the accusers, the crowd, or Jesus’ disciples observing?

Are there areas where you are quick to judge others while ignoring your own sin?

Is there any shame or failure you need to bring honestly to Jesus?

What would it look like for you to receive Jesus’ grace while also taking seriously His call to holiness?

How can our group become a place that speaks truth without condemnation?

Who in your life needs compassion and restoration instead of criticism?
