Bible Text: John 6:60-71 (7:37-39)

Open Up

Why do some churches seem to put a lot of emphasis on the Holy Spirit and some hardly any? Why do you think there's more confusion about who the Holy Spirit is, compared to God the Father and Jesus?

Dig In

Read John 6:60-71

What was the reaction to Jesus' teaching? What did the crowd think was a hard saying? How did the crowd respond?

What do you think v. 62 means? Why is it significant?

What is meant by "no one can come to me unless its granted him by the Father?" (See also Luke 24:45; Acts 16:14; John 12 12:32)

What role does the Holy Spirit play in our salvation (John 16:8; Titus 3:5)? What role does He play in our ongoing spiritual growth?

Read John 7:37-39

Why is v. 38 a good description of the Holy Spirit? Why does it seem that some people are more filled up with the Holy Spirit than others? What are some key ways to experience the Spirit's power?

Read Ephesians 5:18-21

What contrast is Paul trying to make between alcohol and the Holy Spirit? How would you describe being "filled with the Spirit?"

Read Ephesians 4:30 & 1 Thessalonians 5:19

How would you explain what grieving and quenching means in relationship to the Holy Spirit? What's the difference between the two?

How have you experienced what it means to grieve and/or quench the Spirit?
