### Disciples Disciple

**Bible Text:** John 1:35-51 & Matthew 4:18-22

### Open Up

Who first introduced you to something (or someone) that changed your life? How was your life changed?

### Dig In

#### Read John 1:35-42

Do you think John the Baptist was disappointed the disciples left to follow Jesus? Why or why not?

How is John demonstrating good spiritual leadership in this passage?

Jesus asked John the Baptist's disciples (Andrew & John), "What are you seeking?". Why do you think Jesus asked them that question?

What can we learn about discipleship and disciple-making from this passage?

What do you think is the significance to Jesus changing Peter's name? How can this be an encouragement to us?

#### Read John 1:43-51

What was Nathanael's initial reaction about Jesus? What changed his mind?

What can we learn from Philip when trying to share Jesus with people who are skeptical?

#### Read Matthew 4:18-22

What can we learn about discipleship from this passage? How can this passage be a source of encouragement for us who are trying to reach others for Jesus?

### Close Out

*"What are you seeking?"*- Are you seeking Jesus with all your heart? Are there ways you are not seeking Him with pure motives? How so?

*"Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men."*- Are you being intentional in sharing the hope of Jesus with others? Are you actively discipling others? If so, how? If not, why not?
