Bible Text: John 1:19-34, 3:22-31

Open Up

Who is someone you know that you'd consider a great Christian? Why?

Dig In

Sunday we looked at **"How To Be Great For God's Kingdom"** by looking at the life of John the Baptist. Our study will focus on the three points shared on Sunday.

#1 Make life about Jesus instead of ourselves

Read John 1:19-23

How did John's life reveal he lived for Jesus not for himself? How does Paul's words in Acts 20:24 reflect a life lived for Jesus?

How do we see self-absorbed Christianity in our world today? What could help combat this?

How can we as Christians "Make straight the way of the Lord?" How do Christians sometimes making it harder for people to turn to Jesus?

#2 Choose a life of humility

Read John 1:24-28 & 3:22-31

What are some lessons on humility that we can learn from John in these passages? Who is someone else from the Bible who demonstrated humility? How so?

What are some steps you could take to help pursue humility in your life?

#3 Share the gospel unapologetically

Read John 1:29-34

What elements of the gospel did John share in this passage? Which elements of the gospel are missing in what he shared?

Read Colossians 4:24

What can we learn about sharing the gospel from this passage? What's one principle you can put into practice from these verses?
