Bible Text: John 9

Open Up

Have you ever witnessed a miracle or healing? If so, what was it?

Dig In

Read John 9:1-12

Why did the disciples assume the man's blindness was connected to someone's sin (vv. 1–2)? How does Jesus' response challenge common assumptions about suffering (vv. 3–5)?

What do we learn about God's purposes in difficult circumstances? How did the blind man demonstrate faith and obedience? How has God used a hardship in your life for a greater purpose?

Read John 9:13-34

Why were the Pharisees unwilling to accept the miracle Jesus performed? How does pride keep people from seeing spiritual truth today?

The healed man grew in his understanding of Jesus throughout the chapter. What stages of growth do you see in his responses? What warnings do the Pharisees provide for religious people?

Read John 9:35-41

Why do you think Jesus sought out the man after he was cast out? What is significant about the man's response when Jesus revealed Himself as the Son of Man?

According to Jesus, who is truly blind in this story? What is the difference between physical blindness and spiritual blindness? What does it look like to "see" Jesus clearly today?

Which character in the story do you most identify with right now: the disciples, the blind man, the parents, the neighbors, or the Pharisees? Why?

How does this miracle point beyond physical healing to something greater?
