





Learn new technical skills, such as operating sound and lighting equipment, video production, and multimedia presentations. Develop teamwork and communication skills while working closely with our dedicated team.


Enhance the worship experience for our congregation by ensuring high-quality sound, visuals, and broadcasts.


Share the love of Christ with our local community and beyond.


