Small Group Question 1 - How does Nahum describe both God's mercy and His justice?

Small Group Question 2 - How does God's judgment of Nineveh demonstrate His faithfulness to His people?

Small Group Question 3 - God is sovereign over nations and history. How should this truth comfort you today?

# **Teaching Break**

### Habakkuk

Small Group Question 4 - In Habakkuk 1, the prophet calls out for God to deal with all of the injustice he sees around him in Judah. What does God say he will do in response?

Small Group Question 5 - God says that he will judge all wickedness in both Judah and Babylon. What does this reveal about his character?

Small Group Question 6 - Habakkuk invites us to humbly trust in God, even when we don't understand his ways (see 2:4). How does that encourage you?

# Zephaniah

Small Group Question 7 - What is the "Day of the Lord" that Zephaniah says is coming?

Small Group Question 8 - Zephaniah tells us about the global work that God is doing to make a people for himself. How does he describe it? (See second half of chapter 3)

Small Group Question 9 - Why is it significant that God says that HE will bring about salvation for his people?
