- Benediction or formalized greetings

GUIDELINES FOR INTERPRETING EPISTLES

- Use "mirror-reading" with caution
- Divide the text into discourse units
- Understand the organization within a literary unit
- Determine the meaning of individual words
- Apply the message of the text
