Yes, I will give my life to the Lord!

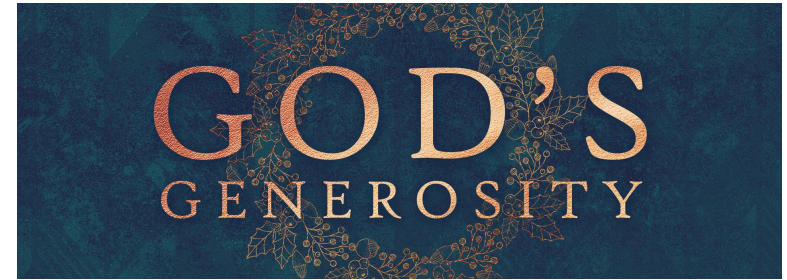
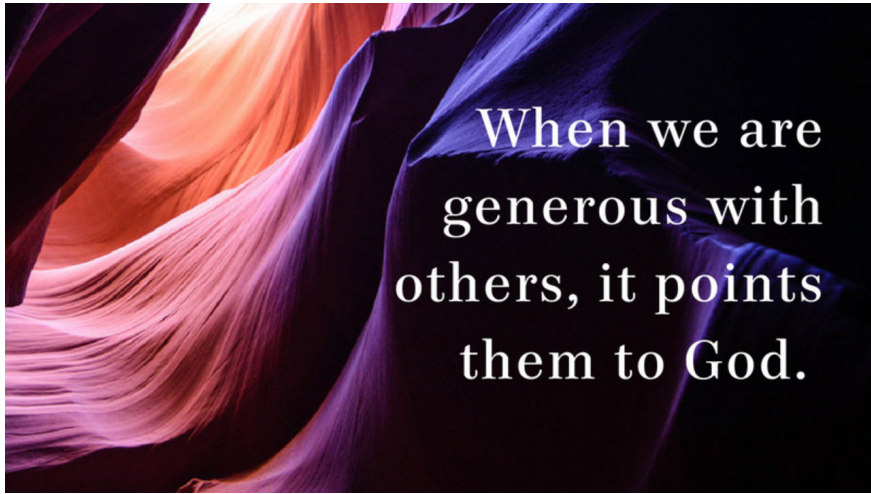
- If you are not into the habit of giving, will you start giving monthly?
