

## FINAL ENCOURAGEMENT (22:12-16)

Jesus says to us:

1. "Behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with me"
2. "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end."
3. "Blessed are those who wash their robes."

There are **7 Beatitudes** in the book of Revelation:

- 1:3
- 14:13
- 16:15
- 19:9
- 20:6
- 22:7
- 22:14

Contrast:

"Outside are the dogs and the sorcerers and the immoral persons and the murderers and the idolaters, and everyone who loves and practices lying."

4. "I Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things for the churches. I am the root and the descendant of David, the bright morning star."

Notice:

- Jesus is **the root and descendant of David** (see Isaiah 11:1,10).
- Jesus is **the bright and morning star** (see Numbers 24:17).

## FINAL INVITATION (22:17)

John gives us a three-fold invitation to come.

The door is always open. But if you come, you must come through Jesus. (John 14:6)

## FINAL WARNING (22:18-19)

The warning is against *adding or taking away* from the prophecies of this book. The same warning is given by Moses in Deuteronomy 4:2.

## FINAL PRAYER (22:20-21)

- "He who testifies to these things says, 'Yes, I am coming quickly.'"
- "Amen. Come, Lord Jesus!"
- "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen."

Jesus' full title is given here.

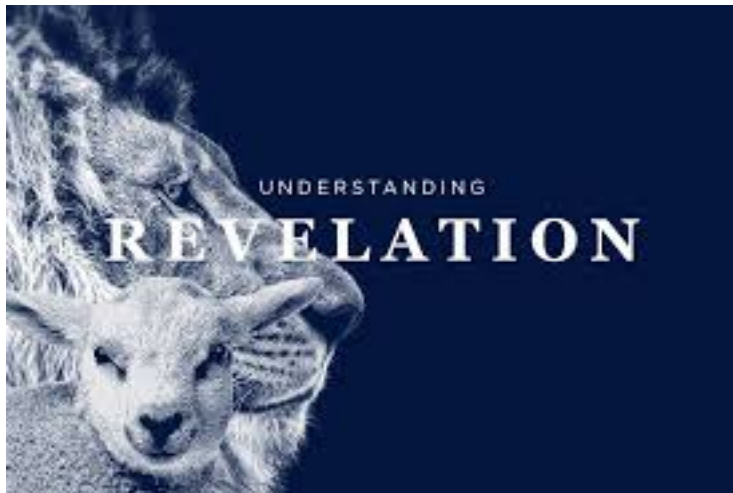
- He is **Lord**.
