STANZA 1: The World Speaks (2:1-3)

The psalmist expresses amazement (incredulity) that the people of the earth would rebel against God.

STANZA 2: The Lord Speaks (2:4-6)

"He ... laughs, the Lord scoffs at them"

"I have installed My King upon Zion, My holy hill"

STANZA 3: The King Speaks (2:7-9)

He said to Me: "You are My Son, today I have begotten You."

Prophetically, this refers to Jesus, who will one day rule over all the universe.

STANZA 4: The Psalmist Speaks (2:10-12)
